This letter will serve as a response to your correspondence of May 22, 2009 wherein you requested clarification regarding enforcement of the "stay away" letters for school related events.

Please advise your client that the District has already made arrangements in order to enforce the "stay away" letters for the following school sponsored events: Prom, Breakfast Cap and Gown Distribution, Senior Picnic, and Senior Trip. A teacher and an administrative intern have been assigned to the four students at these events, and these District employees have been identified to the students.

However please be aware that "Grad Nite" is not a school sponsored event and the District will not have school supervisors in attendance, because this event is hosted by the PTA and students attend "Grad Nite" immediately after the graduation ceremony following the close of the school year.

Please be advised that all four boys do plan to attend "Grad Nite," therefore Mary Doe can make her decision to attend or not attend accordingly.


